Dear Parents/Carers,

Home learning

Please continue to read your child's reading book with them and share stories that they are not yet able to read by themselves. It is really important for children's language development to hear lots of different vocabulary.

Shape play, making equal groups (sharing equally) use of coins, telling the time to the hour on an analogue clock (with hands and numbers), comparing relative heights, lengths and weights of real-life objects and talking about half of amounts and of objects will all add to the mathematical learning within the school day.

Every day clothing and equipment

Apart from PE and Forest school days, children will continue to wear school uniform.

Please ensure that all school uniform is labelled and wellies are brought into school for use on the school field and the outdoor classroom.

If the weather stays warm, please ensure that you apply sun screen to your child before school.
