

# Performance – Statutory Assessment

Key Stage 2 Performance 2024 is shown for the following measures:

- Progress in reading, writing and maths
- Pupils meeting expected standard in reading, writing and maths
- Pupils achieving at a higher standard in reading, writing and maths
- Average score in reading and maths

School performance data should be used with caution given the ongoing impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic, which affected individual schools and pupils differently. We have very small cohorts so the statistic relevance is questionable – schools with 10 or fewer children in a cohort do not publish their data. One child equates to 9% in our school.

**NB 2 children did not sit the statutory tests but are included in national data which has a significant impact on the data for our small cohorts.**

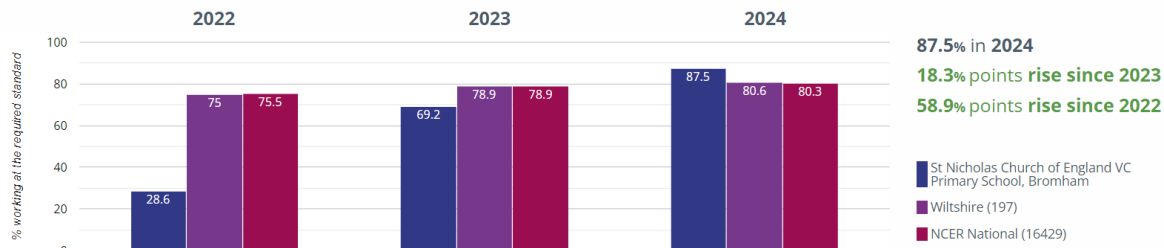
