Promoting British Values

The DfE have reinforced the need ***“to create and enforce a clear and rigorous expectation on all schools to promote the fundamental British values of democracy, the rule of law, individual liberty and mutual respect and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs.”***

Schools, through their curriculum, are legally bound to actively promote the fundamental British values:

- v. Democracy – Respect for democracy and support for participation in the democratic process
- v. The rule of law – respect for the basis on which the law is made and applies in England
- v. Individual liberty - support and respect for the liberties of all within the law
- v. Mutual respect – respect for all
- vi. Tolerance of those of different faiths and beliefs – tolerance of different faiths and religious and other beliefs

These values are taught explicitly through Personal, Social, Health and Emotional (PSHE), and Religious Education (RE). We also teach British Values through planning and delivering a broad and balanced curriculum.

At St Nicholas CofE (VC) Primary School we will actively challenge pupils, staff or parents expressing opinions contrary to fundamental British Values, including ‘extremist’ views. These fundamental British Values are reinforced regularly and in the following ways:
