Parking reminder

The school bible verse is 'Love your neighbour as yourself' and we have been discussing with the children who a neighbour is, encouraging them to think about anybody in need or who we can help. As a valued part of the community, the school is often supported by local residents and this relationship should be reciprocal and a living out of our verse.

Please can this reminder be passed on to everyone who drops off or picks up children at our school? There are three car parks available for children's parents and carers to use when coming to school either in the morning or afternoon. These are the village car park, next to The Greyhound, the car park accessed via Breach Close and the social centre car park in New Road. Personally I would choose one of the two car parks that avoid walking along New Road as it doesn't have a pavement so the other options are safer to walk from and both have pedestrian routes that avoid the traffic. Whilst there is some roadside parking on the High Street, please could we ask you to avoid using this as it blocks up the main road through the village, prevents local residents parking outside their homes and can cause noise and pollution very close to people's windows. There have been occasions when school related cars have been left idling and parked thoughtlessly. I am sure those who have done this have not been aware of the impact of their actions and may well have been in a hurry but please carefully consider the safety and ease of access of all and be considerate to the local residents when you are choosing where to park, using the car parks instead of the roadside.
